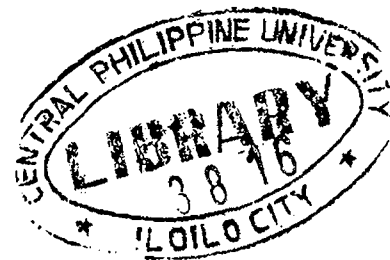

ABSTRACT
