ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the feasibility of establishing an online jobs site for Filipinos in terms of its market and marketing potential, management, technical, financial, social, environmental, regulatory and legal aspects. This study utilized a feasibility study framework that uses data collected from market and management research. A self-administered survey was used to gather data. The study has been conducted in Iloilo City and through an online survey.
