ABSTRACT

This study was designed to develop a Management Information System for Western Visayas Sanitarium. It focused on the following objectives: A database that would store and retrieve patient's record more efficiently and securely, a lab-scheduler module that would generate schedule of laboratory tests for each patient to minimize the queuing outside the laboratory room, a cashier's interface that would determine the total amount to be paid by the patient for laboratory test, a billing and payment module that would process all the billing and payment transactions and generate periodic consolidate reports and a module that would generate reports on common illness on a weekly and monthly basis.

The methodology used for the development of the system was the Iterative System Development Life Cycle which has the following stages: planning and requirements, analysis and design, implementation, testing, evaluation, and deployment.
